"State of Kentucky" Photography Exhibition - 2019

JURY CRITERIA:

The juror will be asked to select photographs that best represent the "state" of Kentucky, both in terms of place and state of being.

ABOUT THE JUROR:

Ed Lawrence has been making photographs since first receiving a Kodak Brownie flash camera for his ninth birthday. The hobby continued through film and darkroom days to our current digital era. His work can be found in public collections in Kentucky and privately throughout the country.

The book "Kentucky 120," a county-by county portrait of Kentucky's landscape was photographed, authored, designed and published by Ed Lawrence in 2014, with a second printing in 2016.

Lawrence is retired from the Kentucky Arts Council and served as arts marketing director for most of his career. He currently hosts the TV show "Art with Ed" on Frankfort Community Television. Ongoing projects include photographing Woods and Water Land Trust sites in the lower Kentucky River watershed and Japanese Gardens in America.

Ed Lawrence is an advocate of all forms and approaches to the art of photography.

ELIGIBILITY AND MEDIA:

To be eligible for this exhibition, a photograph must have been taken within the State of Kentucky (also known as the Commonwealth of Kentucky) by a photographer currently residing in Kentucky (this includes college students who may be temporarily living in state while completing their degree). Both digital and traditional photography may be accepted into this exhibit. All work must be framed and ready to display. All work must have been completed since January of 2015 and not previously shown in any other Community Arts Center exhibitions.

ENTRY:

Digital upload and entry of artwork through our website www.communityartscenter.net is the preferred method of entry. If unable to apply online, works may be submitted on CD. If applying via CD, send all entry information to: Brandon Long, Programming Director, Community Arts Center, 401 W. Main Street, Danville, KY 40422. **All work must be for sale.**

ENTRY FEE AND PROCEDURE:

A non-refundable entry fee of \$25 for 1 to 3 entries and \$35 for 4 to 6 entries allows the artist to enter up to six art works. The fee must be submitted with the completed registration form. The entry fee does not cover the costs of shipping, which are the responsibility of the artist.

All digital images submitted for jurying must be labeled as follows:

1. Title of work
2. Medium
3. Date completed
4. Entry number
5. Framed/Finished dimensions
6. Artist's name

DIGITAL IMAGES:

Digital Images must list all of the above criteria and must be submitted in the following format:

Dimensions: At least 1000 pixels wide

File Format: Baseline JPG (do not use progressive JPG format)

- If entering by mail, CDs must be clearly labeled with the artist's name and address. **CD entries require an additional \$5 for handling** as your images and information must be uploaded to the online jurying portal by Arts Center staff.
- CDs submitted for review will not be returned.

EXHIBITION:

The selected works will be displayed in the Community Arts Center from April 5 through June 14. An opening reception will be held on Friday, April 12 from 5:30-7:00 p.m. No early removal of artwork is allowed for any reason.

SALES:

ALL WORK MUST BE FOR SALE. The Community Arts Center retains a 30% commission on the sale price of all works sold in the gallery. The sale price is the price listed on the registration form. Artists will be notified if/when art is sold and may be required to complete and return a W9 form in order to be paid for the sale.

LIMITATIONS:

- **An entry to this exhibit constitutes full agreement on the part of the artist to all conditions outlined in this proposal, and guarantees that work entered will be available for exhibition. Accepted work that is not delivered or is withdrawn may preclude the artist from eligibility for future Community Arts Center competitions/exhibitions.**
- The Community Arts Center reserves the right to eliminate any entry that requires extensive installation.
- Size limitation: 72" x 72".
- Accepted work that differs significantly from the entry images will be disqualified.
- All work must be framed and wired for hanging.
- Any substandard presentation will be disqualified.

- The juror and/or Community Arts Center Director have final authority to define what constitutes an acceptable entry.
- Hand-delivered work may be picked up from **11 a.m. to 4 p.m.** on June 15. Please let us know if you need additional time to pick up works as the Arts Center will hold works in storage until 4 p.m. on June 22.
- The artist grants permission to the Community Arts Center to reproduce entries for the purpose of publicity (social media, digital advertisement, and/or print advertisement) unless otherwise noted on the entry form.

IDENTIFICATION OF ARTWORK:

Accepted entries must have a legible identification tag on the backside: Artist name, Title of work, Medium, Framed/Finished dimensions, Price, and Date of completion of work.

RECEIVING AND RETURN OF ACCEPTED WORKS:

- Hand-delivered artwork will be received from **10 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Saturday, March 30.** Work may be delivered earlier by appointment. Late entries will not be accepted.
- Mailed entries must be received by no later than **4 p.m. on Saturday, March 30.**
- Packing materials for hand-delivered entries will not be retained by the Community Arts Center.
- Hand-delivered work must be claimed by **4 p.m. on Saturday, June 22.** Works may be picked up as early as 11 a.m. on June 15.
- Unsold mail-in artwork will be packed and returned within two weeks of the close of the exhibition.
- **If shipping artwork to the Community Arts Center, please include return postage and shipping information inside the packing materials.**
- Exact shipping costs must be pre-paid or pre-arranged by artist. No refunds will be made (except in the case of sales).
- For return shipping purposes, artwork will be insured for the amount stated on the shipping form. If no insurance amount is stated, none will be requested.
- The artist is solely responsible for filing insurance claims with their chosen carrier should loss or damage occur during shipping.
- **Work that is not accompanied by return postage or that is not claimed within 30 days after June 15 will become the property of the Community Arts Center and may be disposed of at its discretion.**
